School Uniform for the summer – As the weather gets hotter, children's dress has changed. It is fine for children to be wearing shorts and summer dresses, but children still need to be wearing appropriate uniform. Please can I remind families that jeans and leggings are not appropriate school trousers and please make sure children's dress/skirt length keeps the children appropriately covered when sitting cross legged on the floor. Black school shoes are still required and if children are wearing sandals they must be well fitted so they are safe for children to run around in at playtimes.
