Wellbeing – looking after the children, ourselves and the local residents at pick up and drop off time

There has been yet another incident in Selden Road this week caused by dangerous parking.

Rule 243 of the Highway Code states <u>not to stop or park</u>:

- near a school entrance
- anywhere you would prevent access for Emergency Services
- opposite or within 10 metres (32 feet) of a junction, except in an authorised parking space
- opposite a traffic island or (if this would cause an obstruction) another parked vehicle
- where the kerb has been lowered to help wheelchair users and powered mobility vehicles
- in front of an entrance to a property
- on a bend

Also, rule 244 tells us not to park on the pavement unless signs permit it which we do not have on Selden Road.
