https://www.waycroftacademy.com/web/admissions\_1/ 415912. The deadline is the last working day in February.



If you know of any local families with 1 year olds, please also feel free to share the information with them.





If you come into our main school office, you will be greeted by either **Mrs Bennett**, **Miss Pople** or **Mrs Norfolk** who are happy to help you with any queries, passing on information or to set up a meeting with another member of staff.

Mrs Trickey, our Family Link Worker, leads on our whole school attendance strategy, supports children emotionally in school and is available to provide family support such as if you have concerns about children's behaviour at home, managing children's anxiety or even someone to talk to if you are going through a difficult time.

**Mrs Lucas**, previously Sage, is our SENCO so please arrange to meet her if you have concerns about your children's needs or progress.

Class teachers are available for meetings/conversations. For the early years and KS1, please catch the teacher at drop off/pick up to arrange a mutually agreeable time or via the school office. For key stage 2, you can catch them at the end of the day or via the school office.

If there is an on-going worry that you haven't been able to resolve with the class teacher, the phase leaders are also able to meet with you.

Any finally **Mrs Sweet** (Assistant Head of School) and myself, **Miss Craig** (Head of School), are happy to meet with and talk to families as needed.

As a school, we want all families to feel confident to come in and speak to us about anything. I can assure you that between us we have a vast amount of experience supporting children and their families and no conversation is too big or too small.






